

Satin Flooring Products Qualify For Up to 5 LEED® Credits

MR Credits 5.1 and 5.2

Regional Materials Credit is awarded for using materials which contribute to 10% (1 Point) or 20% (2 Points) of the total project material costs for which 80% of the mass is extracted, processed and manufactured within 800km of project site (is shipped by truck), or 2400km (if shipped by rail or water). These credits would apply mostly to projects in the vicinity of Central Ontario and Quebec. This credit does not require the use of FSC certified lumber. All wood species (Red, Oak, Ash, Maple and Birch) apply to this credit.

MR Credit 7: Certified Wood

(1 Point) Credit is awarded to projects using a minimum of 50% based on material costs, of wood-based materials which have been certified to FSC principles and criteria. LEED projects ordering FSC certified Satin Flooring products could apply 100% of the value of Satin Flooring FSC wood flooring to support this credit

IEQ Credit 4.1: Low Emitting Materials

Adhesive and Sealants: (1 Point) Credit applies only to field applied adhesives and sealants used in the interior of the building during construction phase that meet the thresholds referenced to the credit., Multi-Stik and Redi-Floor adhesives used to adhere our products to concrete slab are low in volatile organic compounds (VOCs) emitting and fall within the prescribed allowable threshold.

IEQ Credit 4.4: Low Emitting Materials

Composite Wood and Laminate Adhesives (1 Point) To achieve credit, all composite wood and aggrifibre materials including core materials, must contain no added urea-formaldehyde resins. Adhesives used to fabricate laminated assemblies containing these products must contain no urea-formaldehyde. Satin Flooring can contribute to this credit as our products are manufactured without urea-formaldehyde.
